Shrimp Harvesting Equipment Check List

- Totes 1 to rinse shrimp-- 1 to Kill Chill Shrimp --? 1 to store/transport shrimp
- Long Handle Nets (min. 6)
- Orange Shrimp Harvest Baskets (min. 6) , 5-Gallon Buckets
- Ice/ Portable Ice Storage Freezer/ 100 Quart Ice Coolers for Drinking Water
- Table to Sort Shrimp on, Buckets for Miscellaneous Aquatic Garbage
- Lots of Young Workers, Properly Attired, Rubber Boots, Gloves, Etc
- Garden Hose supply of Freshwater, to fill vats, rinse shrimp, clean people, etc.
- Awning, and Table to Weight Shrimp at
- Scale and Weighing Containers to place on Scale
- Plastic Bags to Place Shrimp in and Tee Shirt Bags for Customer Convenience
- Designated Person to Record harvest Data (Note book, Clip Boards and Pens)
- Cash Box With Change
- Index Cards (pre-printed) for Customers to leave Address and Phone Numbers
- Rubber Gloves, Aprons for Shrimp Packers, Hose to Wash Hands, Paper Towels
- Smaller 6' x 10' Green Nets for Shrimp Packers
- Road Signs, Marked Parking Area, Trash Barrels
- Safety First--Drinking Water--Chairs and Shade--First Aid Kit
- Sandwiches/ Lunch for Workers, Paper Towels, ? Port-a-Potty
